As a college access organization, the Fulfillment Fund provides first-generation, low-income students with the support necessary to graduate from high school and go on to college.

Through classroom instruction, college counseling, mentoring, scholarships, and post-secondary services, we help transform the lives of students, beginning in high school and extending to college graduation.



## **HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM**

By partnering with high schools we're able to provide individual advisement and class instruction in grades 9-12.

Through these partnerships, we help create a culture of achievement where college can become a realistic and tangible goal for students.

Our classroom-based curriculum focuses on four themes: high school graduation, self-advocacy and empowerment, practical life skills, and college readiness.

## **SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

We provide multi-year college scholarships to Fulfillment Fund students who meet academic and need-based criteria.

In addition to scholarships, our college-enrolled students are able to participate in our internship program, professional networking opportunities and events and receive a quarterly newsletter.

## **COLLEGE TOURS**

We take students on local and overnight college site visits to Northern and Southern California schools so they can explore college options, experience college environments and begin to envision themselves as college students.

## **MENTORING**

Recognized as among the best in the state, our mentoring program helps students reach their highest potential through a professionally-supported relationship with a caring and committed adult mentor.

Students in need of mentoring are selected from partner middle schools in LAUSD.

We offer extensive training, support, programs and workshops to our student-mentor teams, and closely case-manage the mentoring relationship.

## **COLLEGE COUNSELING AND GUIDANCE**

We create a personalized education plan, including a list of potential colleges and universities. We also provide SAT, financial aid, and college application workshops.

Counselors support students with completing college applications, writing college essays, financial aid advising, and college matching.

## **OUR RESULTS**

Fulfillment Fund students graduate high school at a higher rate than their peers and the majority go on to college.

Our impact expands beyond the students we serve directly; they, in turn, influence siblings, peers and their community by becoming role models, volunteers, mentors and donors.
